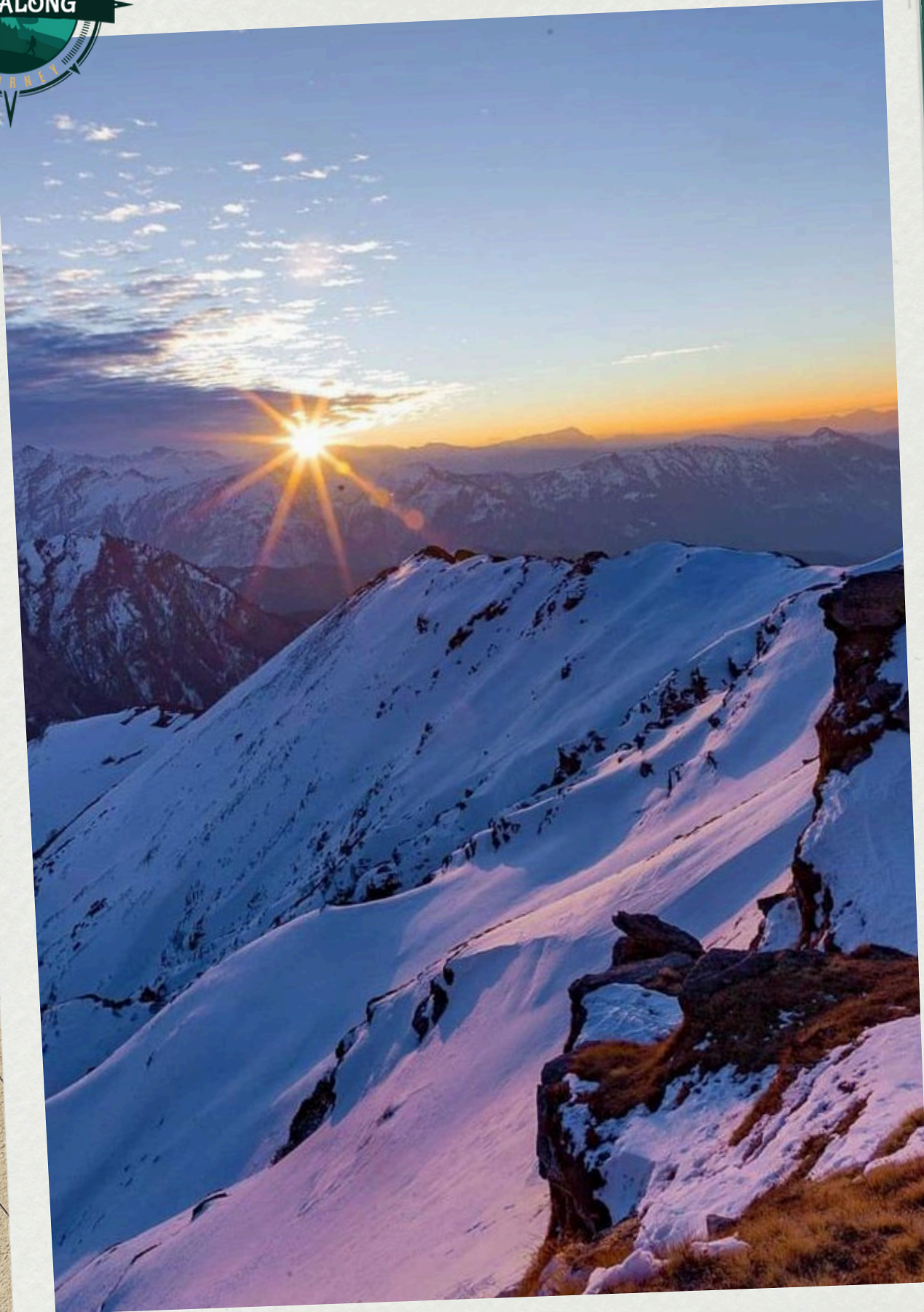

# EXPLORE KEDARKANTHA





## HIGHLIGHTS

The tour begins in Shimla, the ancient summer capital of the British Raj and current capital of Himachal Pradesh. You will drive along the Satluj River Gorge in Kinnaur's semi-desert valley, where the towering Kinner Kailash stands. Kinnaur is also well-known for its traditional Kinnauri architecture communities with temples dedicated to local deities. Kedarkantha is a mountain peak of the Himalayas in Uttarakhand, India. Its elevation is 12,500 ft (3,800 m). Kedarkantha is located within Govind Wildlife Sanctuary in Uttarkashi district. A trek to the peak of Kedarkantha usually starts from Sankri, a small village, and takes four days to complete. There are several myths about Kedarkantha and Juda ka Talab, a high-altitude lake.





# Travel Itinerary

## DAY 01

### DEHRADUN TO SANKRI

Upon arrival in Dehradun, our team will meet at the railway station and head to Sankri village. Drive along Yamuna and Tons rivers, passing pine forests. Arrive at a guesthouse, briefed by the group leader, and enjoy lunch and overnight stay.

## DAY 02

### SANKRI - JUDA KA TALAB

Depart Sankri Village and embark on a trek through streams, a traditional staircase path, and a forest. Arrive at Juda Ka Talab, where Lord Shiva's hair opened a massive lake. Enjoy lunch and a restful night's sleep in tents, taking in the star-studded sky and frozen Juda lake.

## DAY 03

### JUDA KA TALAB - KEDARKANTHA BASECAMP

Descend to the main Indo-Tibet border road, driving through a narrow valley along the Sutlej River's opposite flow. Stop briefly at Khab, where the Sutlej emerges from a gorge and meets the Spiti River. After passing several villages, arrive in Tabo by late afternoon. Founded in 996 A.D., Tabo Monastery, often called the "Ajanta of the Himalayas," holds great significance in Trans-Himalayan Buddhism, second only to Tibet's Tholing Gompa. Stay overnight at a guesthouse. Foreign nationals, please keep your passport and inner line permit handy for checks at three checkpoints.



## DAY 04

### KEDARKANTHA BASECAMP - PEAK SUMMIT - JUDA KA TALAB

Prepare for the final challenge, starting early at 2 a.m. and taking 7 to 8 hours to reach the top of the Yamunotri, Gangotri, and Garhwal ranges. Enjoy warm sunrays and the stunning view of the sun rising over the horizon. Visit the incomplete Shiva Temple and Ganesha Temple before descending to base camp. Enjoy lunch before heading to the Juda Ka Talab campsite for a delectable meal.

## DAY 05

### JUDA KA TALAB - SANKRI - DEHRADUN

After a delicious breakfast at the Juda camp. As you descend to Sankri village, get prepared at hotel with your luggage to take your vehicle which will drop you at Dehradun around 7 - 8 PM. Here concludes the bundle of Kedarkantha trek with a lovely memory
