LADAKH - ZANSKAR BIKE TRIP

Embark on the adventure of a lifetime with the Ladakh-Zanskar bike trip! Ride through breathtaking Himalayan landscapes, conquer challenging mountain passes like Khardung La and Zojila, and explore the pristine beauty of Zanskar Valley. Witness serene monasteries, vibrant prayer flags, and turquoise rivers winding through rugged terrain. Experience the thrill of off-road biking on some of the world's highest roads. Soak in the tranquility of Pangong Lake and Tso Moriri, and marvel at the ancient culture of this remote region. This journey offers a perfect blend of adventure, nature, and spirituality. A dream come true for every biker!





DISTANCE: 540 KM | TRAVEL TIME: 12-14 HOURS

The journey begins with an overnight drive from Delhi to Manali, passing through scenic landscapes and mountainous terrain. You'll arrive in Manali the next morning and check into your accommodation, preparing for the adventure ahead.

DAY 00 - DELHITO MANALI



DAY 01 - MANALI ACCLIMATIZATION DAY

DISTANCE: N/A | TRAVEL TIME: N/A | DIFFICULTY: EASY

Spend the day exploring Manali and acclimatizing to the high altitude. Visit local attractions like the Hadimba Temple, Solang Valley, and Old Manali. It's essential to rest and allow your body to adjust before heading further into the mountains





DAY 02 - MANALI TO PURNE

DISTANCE: 200 KM | TRAVEL TIME: 8-10 HOURS | DIFFICULTY: MODERATE

After breakfast, drive towards Purne, passing through the Atal Tunnel for a scenic photo-op. Continue through Keylong and Darcha before heading towards the challenging Shinku La (5,090 meters), a high-altitude pass offering stunning views of snow-capped peaks. After crossing Shinku La, enjoy the sight of Gonbok Rangan, a towering mountain that adds to the rugged beauty of the region. Finally, arrive in the remote village of Purne, where you'll stay overnight.



DAY 03 - PURNE TO PHUGTAL MONASTERY TO PADUM

DISTANCE: 70 KM | TRAVEL TIME: 8-10 HOURS | DIFFICULTY: MODERATE TO HARD

Begin the day with a trek to the iconic Phugtal Monastery, located in a remote valley. The monastery, built into the cliffs, is a remarkable sight and an important spiritual site. After the visit, continue your drive towards Padum, the administrative town of Zanskar. The day is long and physically demanding due to the trek and the mountainous roads.





DAY 04 - PADUM TO LAMAYURU VIA LINGSHED

<u>Distance: 180 km | Travel Time: 8-10 hours |</u> <u>Difficulty: Moderate</u>

Begin your journey from Padum to Lamayuru via Lingshed, traversing challenging terrain with steep ascents and sharp descents. The route crosses two highaltitude passes: Singe La (4,900 meters) and Sirsir La (4,800 meters), offering stunning views of the Zanskar Range. The landscape features rugged mountains, vast desert-like valleys, and the serene Zangla Valley. Along the way, you'll be captivated by the rugged beauty of the landscape before reaching Lamayuru, renowned for its ancient monastery, nestled in the heart of this mesmerizing terrain.



DAY 05 - LAMAYURU TO LEH

<u>Distance: 120 km | Travel Time: 4-5 hours | Difficulty:</u> <u>Moderate</u>

Today, journey from Lamayuru to Leh, crossing the famous Fotu La (4,108 meters), one of the highest passes in the region. The road offers breathtaking views of the Indus River and surrounding mountains. On the way, you'll also pass the enigmatic Magnetic Hill, known for its unique optical illusion where vehicles appear to move uphill. Once you reach Leh, take time to explore the local attractions such as the Leh Palace, Shanti Stupa, and the bustling local market, soaking in the rich culture and stunning landscapes.





DAY 06 - LEH TO NUBRA VALLEY

Distance: 160 km Moderate

Start early as you drive to Nubra Valley via the Khardung La (5,359 meters), one of the highest motorable passes in the world. The road to Nubra offers spectacular panoramic views of the surrounding peaks and valleys. Nubra Valley is famous for its scenic beauty, desert landscapes, and Bactrian camels.

Distance: 160 km | Travel Time: 5-7 hours | Difficulty:



DAY 07 - NUBRA VALLEY TO PANGONG VIA SHYOK VALLEY

DISTANCE: 200 KM | TRAVEL TIME: 7-8 HOURS | DIFFICULTY: MODERATE

Today's journey takes you through the stunning Shyok Valley, a remote and beautiful area offering views of the majestic peaks and rugged landscapes. Cross the Shyok River and continue to Pangong Lake, one of the most breathtaking spots in Ladakh, known for its ever-changing shades of blue.





DAY 08 - PANGONG TO HANLE

DISTANCE: 120 KM | TRAVEL TIME: 4-5 HOURS | DIFFICULTY: MODERATE

Travel from Pangong to Hanle, passing through picturesque terrains with dramatic mountain views. Hanly offers tranquility and is a great stop to relax and acclimatize before the next challenging leg of the journey.



DAY 09 - HANLE TO UNMING LA TO TSO MORIRI

DISTANCE: 150 KM | TRAVEL TIME: 7-8 HOURS | DIFFICULTY: HARD

Today, you'll tackle the demanding Unming La (5,799 meters), a high-altitude pass offering stunning vistas of the surrounding mountains and valleys. After crossing the pass, head towards Tso Moriri, a high-altitude lake, known for its pristine beauty and wildlife, including migratory birds and wild yaks.





DAY 10 - TSO MORIRI TO SARCHU

DISTANCE: 150 KM | TRAVEL TIME: 6-8 HOURS | DIFFICULTY: HARD

Leaving Tso Moriri, you'll head towards Sarchu, passing through the mighty Baralacha La (4,890 meters). The terrain is challenging with steep ascents and descents, but the views of the rugged, barren landscape make it a memorable day. Sarchu is the last major stop before descending into Manali.



DAY 11 - SARCHU TO MANALI

<u>Distance: 230 km | Travel Time: 9-11 hours | Difficulty:</u> <u>Moderate to Hard</u>

On this final leg of your journey, you'll cross several major passes including the Tanglang La (5,328 meters) and the Rohtang Pass before descending into Manali. The long and winding roads are filled with magnificent views of the Himalayan range, providing one last opportunity to capture the essence of Ladakh's untouched beauty.





DAY 12 - MANALI TO DELHI

DISTANCE: 540 KM | TRAVEL TIME: 12-14 HOURS

After a restful night in Manali, begin your return journey to Delhi. Arriving in Delhi marks the end of this adventurous trip, filled with breathtaking mountain passes, serene lakes, ancient monasteries, and remote valleys—an experience that will last a lifetime.

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INCLUSION

• Accommodation will be provided on a triple-sharing basis as per the itinerary in the listed hotels/camps or similar. For couples, twin-sharing accommodation will be arranged, subject to prior confirmation.

• A set menu of vegetarian meals will be provided, including daily breakfast and dinner, starting from the first day's dinner and continuing until the last day's breakfast at the hotels and camps.

- The Royal Enfield Himalayan 411 CC, including petrol, will be provided for use as per the itinerary. For the bike package, it will be limited to one bike per rider or one bike for two riders.
- A dedicated and experienced road captain, well-versed in the routes and region, will accompany the group. Additionally, a skilled mechanic with expertise in handling and repairing Royal Enfield bikes will be available throughout the trip.
- A backup vehicle will be available for emergencies, equipped with essential items such as spare parts, medical kit and an oxygen cylinder. It will also carry one 15 kg bag per rider.
- Transfers from Delhi to Manali and Manali to Delhi will be provided by Volvo, along with airport/hotel transfers in Srinagar on a shared (SIC) basis. If you prefer private transfers, additional charges will apply
